I am writing to request a postponement of the public scoping meetings planned this week for June 27 and June 28 regarding the Environmental Impact Statement for the proposed West Los Angeles Real Property Exchange. I am also requesting that any future public scoping meetings be rescheduled with at least 30-days notice.

Last week my office received a Notice of Agency Scoping Meeting For Environmental Impact Statement Army Reserve West Los Angeles Property Exchange dated June 18, 2007. The notice included a fact sheet from the 63D Regional Readiness Command with information on the project background and location, NEPA process, public outreach and involvement, alternatives being considered and public comment period. This was the first time my office was made aware of the dates, times and locations for the public scoping meetings. It was also the first time my office had seen the fact sheet. In addition, many constituents have contacted my office because they had also received the materials on short notice. I am concerned that this brief amount of time is inadequate for interested parties to review the released materials and make plans to attend the meeting. Therefore, I am requesting that the Army postpone the scheduled public scoping meetings set for Wednesday, June 27 and Thursday, June 28, 2007 and reschedule with at least 30-days notice.

I appreciate your attention to my concern and request a response by close of business tomorrow.
